VICTORIA GOLD CORP. 5TH ANNUAL GOLF TOURNAMENT RAISES \$80K FOR YUKON STUDENTS

WHITEHORSE, **YUKON** – Victoria Gold Corp. ("**VGCX**") hosted its 5th annual charity golf tournament this month and successfully raised \$80,000 for *Every Student*, *Every Day* ("**ESED**"), a project funding program operated by the Victoria Gold Yukon Student Encouragement Society (the "**Society**"), to support projects designed to curb the high rates of school absenteeism and to increase Yukon student attendance and engagement.

"This tournament raised a record amount of funds for Every Student, Every Day. Thanks to the generosity and commitment of our donors and community partners who continue to support this cause that's close to their hearts," said Tara Christie, President of Victoria Gold Yukon Student Encouragement Society. "This year, we were able to further increase our funding contribution from \$300,000 to \$350,000 for the 2023-24 school year for Yukon schools, school councils and First Nations governments. The funds raised at this tournament will allow us to continue to increase our funding and connect with the communities to support their projects to increase student attendance."

- Contributed towards helping increase graduation rates in the Yukon.
