- How the project supported attendance, engagement, connection or student well-being; or
- Simply why ESED support mattered to your school, program or students.

Please include your name, school/program/organization and your ESED testimonial.

More Than One ESED Story? Send Them!

Schools, programs and organizations may submit more than one testimonial if they have multiple ESED-funded projects or stories to share. Each eligible testimonial will count as a separate contest entry.

There is a maximum of one prize per school, program or organization, regardless of the number of entries submitted.

Bonus Entry: Show Us ESED in Action!

Include at least one photograph from an ESED-funded project with your testimonial and you will receive one bonus entry.

If identifiable students or other individuals appear in a submitted photograph, the entrant is responsible for ensuring that the appropriate permissions or consents are in place for the photograph to be shared with and used by Every Student, Every Day.

The Prizes

There are eight Tetris Tumble XL games available to be won. Eight winners will be selected following the contest closing date, with a maximum of one prize per school, program or organization.

Prizes have no cash value and cannot be exchanged for cash.

Winner Selection, Permissions & Final Details

Selecting the Winners

Each eligible testimonial receives one entry in the draw. A testimonial submitted with at least one eligible photograph receives one additional entry, for a maximum of two entries per testimonial.

Eight winners will be selected at random after the contest closes.

If more than one winning entry is associated with the same school, program or organization, only one prize will be awarded and another eligible entry will be drawn.

Winners will be contacted using the contact information provided with their submission.

Permission to Share Your Story

By entering the contest, you give Every Student, Every Day permission to use your submitted testimonial in ESED communications, including our website, social media, newsletters, reports, presentations and promotional materials.

ESED may edit a testimonial for spelling, grammar, length or clarity, but will not change its meaning.

By submitting photographs, you also give ESED permission to reproduce and publish those photographs in ESED communications.

ESED will not identify individual students by name unless separate permission has been provided.
